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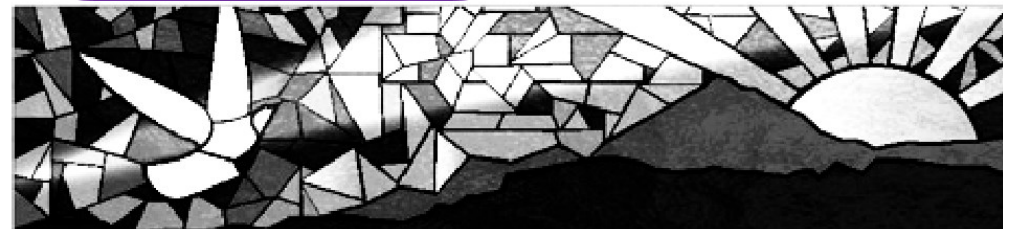

- Any cardboard glove packaging (this can be recycled through your local council)
- Marigold gloves used for professional or business purposes (non-domestic)



Rotherwick's Village Magpies 'TerraCycle Tuesday'



It is really important that we all try to refuse to accept plastic packaging and reuse plastic where possible to cut down on the use of oil to create virgin plastic, which is sadly so often discarded as very long-lasting litter in our beautiful world.

If you do use plastics though, we have a new scheme to encourage recycling and raise money for local charities. At the moment Hart collect only a limited range of materials for recycling in our blue wheelie bins and green glass box, but there are actually lots of other items which could be recycled.

So, on 'TerraCycle Tuesday' when you put out your wheelie bins remember you can now also bring us your other recyclable items to Rooks Farm Cottage (opp. Coach & Horses).

We also have purple wheelie bins at:

- **Whitewater School**
- **Band Hall Place, Hook (the first house on the left through the footpath from Boots)**
- **The Rectory on Vicarage Lane, Hound Green**

We hope to have even more collection points coming soon.

Once we have reached the minimum weight needed for each 'waste stream' we can send it off to TerraCycle and in return we will receive money to donate to local groups: currently we are supporting the 1st Bramshill Scouts Rotherwick, Whitewater School PTA and the parish churches of Heckfield, Mattingley and Rotherwick.

Check out the table on pages 11-15 for all our accepted waste.



The items which will directly benefit Rotherwick's charities are those in the first 11 categories: cheese wrappers, Ferrero Rocher, Kinder, beauty/skincare packaging, Weleda creams, Baylis & Harding pumps and caps, L.O.L. Surprise! toys and home hygiene items such as dishwasher tablet bags and cleaning wipe packets.

We have just been accepted onto three new schemes: Marigold gloves, Lavazza coffee eco caps and Hasbro games. If you're having a pre-Christmas sort out of toys, please check the list to see if any that are too tatty for the Charity Shop could be recycled with us.

We cannot accept items which can be put into your blue wheelie bin – such as paper, card, plastic bottles, cans and aerosols even if these are from any of the brands listed.

We are also happy to accept many other items, such as crisp, confectionery and biscuit packets. We do not receive money for these, but will pass them on to other collectors who do.

We know the list can feel a bit overwhelming, so please remove the central pages of the RN and keep it somewhere prominent so you can check what is acceptable.

Please sort your waste into the different 'streams' if at all possible. Putting the flattened packets of any one type inside one of the larger packets of the same type will save us a lot of time and mean we can get more into each box we send away. Or you could use a bread bag for each stream.
