1st Bramshill Rotherwick Beaver, Cubs and Scouts

Friday the 3rd May 2019 saw the Cubs and Scouts from 1st Bramshill Rotherwick arrive at camp along with 7th Bramshill, Hook for a weekend of fun activities.

Upon arrival tents were pitched, bags unpacked and the St George's cross was raised to signal the start of this year's camp. The Scouts built fires which were required to be kept alight for the whole weekend. They needed the fires as they operate self-sufficiently with their own food cooking. Their rations were issued and while supervised, they were pretty independent from the younger Cubs.

9pm was bedtime. A late night followed, as all the young Cubs were excited to be sleeping in their tents with their mates.



Saturday morning saw them up and eating breakfast.

Whilst campers were getting organised for the day's activities: pine poles, climbing, shooting and raft building to name a few. The leaders were eagerly awaiting our younger members - the Beavers.

At 10am the Beavers arrived and they were thrust into an orienteering adventure to get accustomed to the camp and location of everything. Scouts and Cubs were either climbing, shooting and maintaining fires, whilst the excitable Beavers were in the adventure playground.

Lunchtime and it was the Beavers turn on the climbing tower. This is great for them to learn their limits as well as pushing themselves letting the confidence grow the higher and higher they climb.

To all the young boys and girls who attended this year's camp: you encouraged one another; your team work and resilience was second to none; and your positivity was infectious. MEMBERS: Cllrs Lucy Bardwell (Chair), Rachel Johnson (Vice Chair), Katy Fox, Daniel Margetson, Hugh Radesk, Andrew Sinclair & Jonathan Wort.

ELECTION OF CHAIRMAN AND VICE-CHAIRMAN: Cllr Lucy Bardwell and Cllr Rachel Johnson were unanimously elected Chairman and Vice Chairman of Rotherwick Parish Council respectively.

CO-OPTED COUNCILLOR: Following the Co-option process, Jonathan Wort was unanimously elected a Councillor of Rotherwick Parish Council.

COUNTY & DISTRICT CLLRS: HDC’s newly elected Independent Cllr Dermot Smith introduced himself to members before having to leave to attend Hook Parish Council meeting.

APOLOGIES: were received and accepted from Cllr Jonathan Glen & HDC Cllr Jane Worlock.

Policing Priorities Quarterly Meeting - Cllr Katy Fox attended the meeting held on Sunday, 28th April and reported that, anti-social behaviour in open spaces with a particular focus on recreational areas will be this quarter’s priority. This priority comes about in conjunction with the lighter evenings and warmer weather. Subjected to ‘funding cuts, by the end of the year it is hoped that 2 new PCSOs and 2 PCs will join the team.

Operation London Bridge - RPC will contact the Rotherwick Church Warden and the Village Hall Committee to ask if they have agreed protocols in the event of the death of HM The Queen or other senior Royals. RPC’s own book of condolence is favoured.

Hampshire & IOW Wildlife Trust - Hampshire & IOW Wildlife Trust will hold a Fungus Foray in Hudson Copse on the 12 October between 10.30 - 13.00. The Falcon have kindly offered them car parking facilities.

Lengthsman Scheme 2019/2020 - RPC will compile a list of jobs for this year’s Lengthsman Scheme as well as arrange a meeting with the Cluster Administrator ASAP to discuss management of works.

North Hampshire Cricket Association Evening League Division 2

We have so far played 3 out of 4 scheduled matches in this league and currently lie in 4th position. The opening game, on 1st May, was away versus old rivals Sherfield-on-Loddon where a fine 70 from opener Gregg Cloete propelled us to a close 3 run victory. Rotherwick ITW 109/7, Sherfield-on-Loddon 106/4. We travelled to AWE Tadley on 15th May and came away with a good 14 run victory with a lusty 47 not out from James Barter sealing the win. Rotherwick ITW 106/7, AWE Tadley 92/6. Herriard were our visitors on 22 May and they put paid to our table topping position after we became bogged down during the middle overs of our innings, eventually losing by 16 runs. Herriard 99/4, Rotherwick ITW 83/7. These matches were all 16 overs per side. Our scheduled visit to Stratton Park to play Development Group on 29th May was halted by rain, which wiped out all the division's fixtures that evening.

Hampshire Cricket League – Regional Division 1 North-East

All 3 of our scheduled games in this competition have been played, but with mixed results and we are currently 15th in the league after just 1 victory.

The opening game on 11 May at Bramshill versus Hartley Wintney III was threatened by a pre-match hailstorm of biblical proportions but the wicket had thankfully been covered. We posted an under-par score of 137 (Paul Buckingham 41) which didn't really tax the home side who completed their 5 wicket win in the 36th over. Rotherwick ITW 137 all out, Hartley Wintney III 141/5. Chris Bradshaw took 3/29. At home on 18 May against 10 man Bentworth a magnificent opening bowling spell from John Holder (8 overs, 5 maidens, 6 wickets for 6 runs) tore the heart out of our visitors and they succumbed to 25 all out in just 17 overs. We lost 1 wicket completing the 9 wicket victory. Bentworth 25 all out, Rotherwick ITW 29/1. It was our turn to be rolled over for a low score (83) at AWE Tadley on 25 May and this proved no obstacle to the home side who recorded



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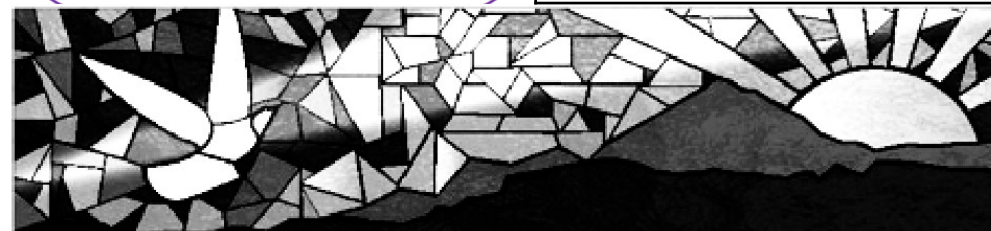
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a 9 wicket win. Rotherwick ITW 83 all out, AWE Tadley 87/1

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Hook and Hartley Wintney Medical Equipment Fund

For many years Whitewater Health has hosted a charity for the benefit of our patients. This has been to provide services and equipment over and above that usually provided for in General Practice. In the past few years we have supported a number of exciting projects that have been hugely beneficial to our patients.

In conjunction with Odiham Cottage Hospital Combined Trust we have created a LINK nurse post to provide help and support to those in the community unable to access the services of the surgeries. The emphasis has been on prevention of illness and disability and promoting health and quality of life. This has been an enormous success and they have made a real difference to the health and well-being of those who have been in receipt of their care.

We have also set up White-water Garden for Health which provides Ecotherapy for our

patients by funding an allotment in Hook. Patients are referred or can self-refer and is used to improve physical and mental well-being.

Generous support from Odiham Consolidated Charities has enabled us to provide additional equipment for the surgeries including spirometers and cardiac event monitors which allow patients to have investigations in-house they would otherwise need to travel to hospital to receive.

Lions club has also donated money to go towards a new device called a FeNo monitor which helps diagnose and monitor asthma

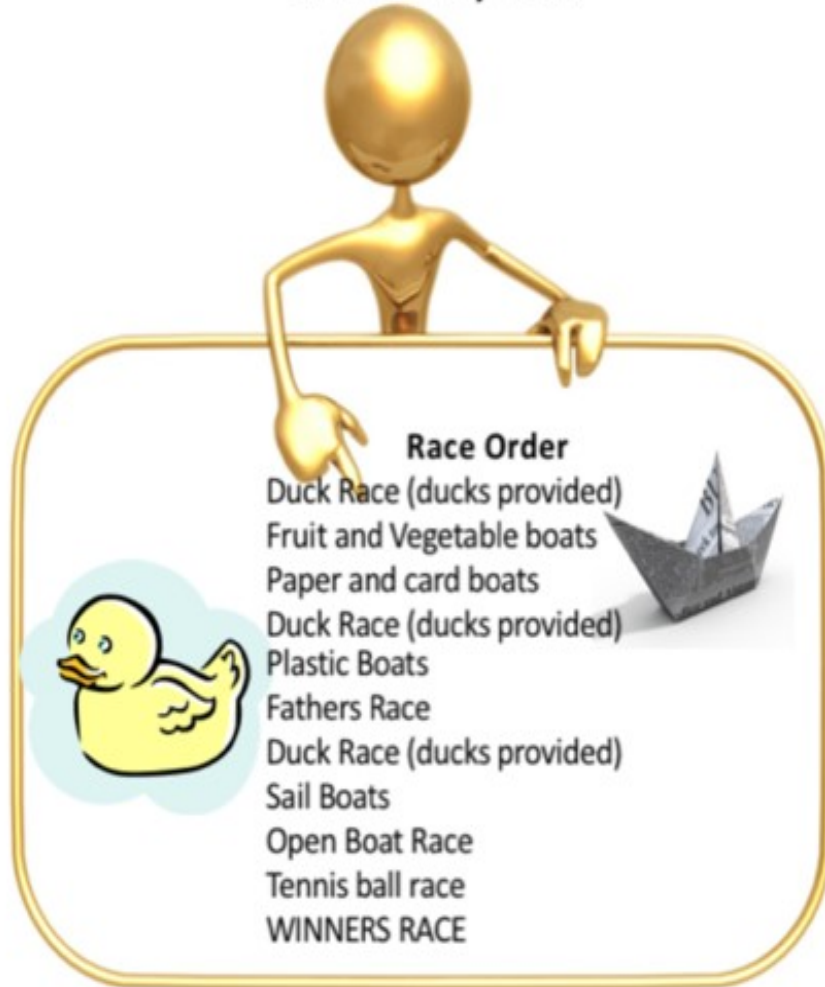


Rotherwick Tennis Club is on the playing fields just before the Ty-lney Park Golf Club. The court can be pre-booked and access is by combination lock.
